

AMENDMENT OFFERED BY MR. KELLER
TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A
SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 4334

At the end of title I, add the following (and make such technical and conforming changes as may be appropriate):

1 SEC. 123. TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY.

2 (a) DEFINITIONS.—Section 102 of the Older Ameri-
3 cans Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3002) is amended—

4 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (H)
5 through (L) as subparagraphs (I) through (M), re-
6 spectively,

7 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (G) the fol-
8 lowing:

9 “(H) screening for fall-related traumatic
10 brain injury, coordination of treatment, reha-
11 bilitation and related services, and referral serv-
12 ices;”, and

13 (3) by adding at the end the following:

14 “(55) The term ‘traumatic brain injury’ has the
15 meaning given to it in section 339B(d) of the Public
16 Health Service Act.”.

1 (b) HEALTH SCREENING.—Section 321(a)(8) of the
2 Older Americans Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C.3030d(a)(8)) is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 “(8) services designed to provide health screen-
5 ing (including mental and behavioral health screen-
6 ing, falls prevention services screening and traumatic
7 brain injury screening) to detect or prevent (or both)
8 illnesses and injuries that occur most frequently in
9 older individuals;”.

10 (c) ACTIVITIES FOR HEALTH.—Section 411(a)(12) of
11 the Older Americans Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3032(a)(12))
12 is amended to read as follows:

13 “(12) building public awareness of cognitive im-
14 pairments such as Alzheimer’s disease and related
15 disorders with neurological and organic brain dys-
16 function, depression, mental health disorders, and
17 traumatic brain injury;”.
